**COMPETITION REGULATION AND RACING RULES:**

The Macau 2010 CCWC will comply with the IDBF Competition Regulations and will be conducted under the IDBF Rules of Racing.



### **DIVISIONS, RACING & COMPETITION CLASSES**

The Championships that will be contested are listed below provided sufficient entries are received in each competition class. Entries from up to five (5) crews per competition class, per Country or Territory, will be allowed.

A minimum of six (6) different IDBF Members are required for a competition class to be given world championship status. A minimum of three (3) IDBF Members per competition class are required to qualify for IDBF Championship status.

### **Age Regulations:**

- (1) **Seniors: A** - Over 40; **Senior B (Grand Dragons):** over 50 as of 1 June 2010.
- (2) **Junior: A** - Under 18 but 12 or over; **Junior B** Under 16 but 12 or over as 1 January 2010.
- (3) **Under 23s** - Under 23 but 18 or over as at 1 Jan 2010. 6 crew members may be U18.

### **ENTRIES:**

All Entries are to be sent to IDBF directly, with all administrative information and returns going to the Macau 2010 CCWC Organizing Committee.

Each entry must be sanctioned by the IDBF Member Organization to which the Club Crew is affiliated, where one exists. Crews from countries or territories where there is not an IDBF Member may compete subject to the approval of the IDBF Executive Committee.

### **PARTICIPANTS PHOTOGRAPHS**

All participants that is, competitors, coaches, managers, supporters and any other members who have paid the registration fee, are required to submit ( 2 ) passport size ( 4 cm x 6 cm ) photographs. The name of the person and club crew is to be clearly written on the back of each photograph.

If photographs are submitted electronically by e-mail each photo must measure (4 cm x 6 cm) and be not more than 200KB. Each e-mail picture must clearly identify the person concerned with the individual's name and crew written below the picture image.



**REGATTA FEES (Registration Fee + Administration Fee)**

An IDBF Registration Fee of USD 10.00 per person is to be paid by all participants. For this CCWC **no Administration fee will be charged by the local Organizers.**

**ACCOMMODATION AND LOCAL TRANSPORTATION**

The Organizing Committee of Macau 2010 CCWC have made arrangements for a choice of accommodation packages, ranging from **USD 50 to USD 140** per person per day, which will include:

- 5 nights Accommodation (Bed & Breakfast) in a choice of three-star to five-star Hotels,
- Arrival/Departure Transport Service (one trip on arrival and one trip on departure, per competing Club),
- Transport between Official Hotel and Competition Site, during training days and racing days,
- Transportation between Official Hotel and Celebration Dinner.

The complete list of official hotels and package prices will be available in Information Bulletin N°2, after the Provisional Entries have been processed.

Participants are entitled to make their own arrangements, but races will not be delayed for crews that are not staying in the officials hotels or travel under private arrangements.

**RACE DAY LUNCHES**

Lunches will be available to all competitors and their coaches, managers and registered supporters at the competition venue, various menus will be provided and the prices range at USD 10 – 22 per set.

**CELEBRATION DINNER**

**A complementary Celebration Dinner** Party will be provided for all competitors and their coaches, managers and registered supporters, but the total number of participants must be given to Macau 2010 CCWC Organizing Committee by 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2010.

**PAYMENTS**

- Registration Fee is to be paid to IDBF upon arrival
- Accommodation and local transportation payments are to be made to the local Organizers by electronic transfer in US Dollars no later than the relevant deadline.
